



Grant Writing Information

1. Obtain a current Press Release about the organization
2. Get to know everything there is to know about the organization
3. Make sure the organization has a Website or Blog that adequately defines them
4. Gather information including finances, minutes, fund raising campaigns, past donors
5. Has the organization developed a relationship with the foundation who will be granting the money?
6. Obtain and study the grant
7. Add relevant pictures about your organization
8. Tell a story about real people who have benefited from your organization
9. Do not write a novel keep it short
10. Considering that each grant is different, you must answer all of their questions and provide the grantor with all necessary documents
11. After you receive the money, send them a follow-up thank you and a progress report
